What does Legal Aid do? They provide lawyers at an affordable cost to people who need assistance for criminal or civil legal matters and who are unable to retain a lawyer from their own resources. Types of legal problems covered include criminal charges, child welfare matters, maintenance, custody, divorce, or other family matters, immigration issues, administrative tribunals, and other general lawsuits.

It is an information service and is not connected with Legal Aid - nor does it provide any form of financially subsidized legal service.
